- ❖ Why does Aslan wait for Shasta to speak?
- ❖ Why is important that Aslan is a living being?
- ❖ Why has Aslan helped Shasta through both comfort and the threat of danger?
- ❖ Why hasn't Aslan made His presence known until now?
- ❖ Why doesn't Aslan tell anyone any story but her/his own?
- ❖ How is Aslan's naming of Himself as "Myself" related to God's Holy Name in Exodus? Why is it threefold?
- ❖ Compare Elijah's encounter with the "sound of sheer silence" to Aslan's final whisper in His Naming.
- ❖ Why does Aslan appear as both terrible and beautiful?
- ❖ Why does light emanate from Aslan?
- ❖ Why can't Shasta speak? Why doesn't he want to speak?
- ❖ Compare Aslan's disappearance to Jesus' on the Road to Emmaus.
