Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe Chapter 5:

- ❖ Edmund's plan was to get his siblings to come back to Narnia, but instead he decided to be cruel to Lucy. Why might he have done that?
- ❖ Discuss the Professor's act of listening without interrupting Peter and Susan. How does doing so help him take in more information? How does it help him give advice to Susan and Peter?
- ❖ Susan is caught off-guard because the Professor doesn't talk like she expects a grown-up would. What might her expectations of an adult be? How does the Professor act differently from what she might expect?
- Discuss the Professor's logic on why Lucy is likely telling the truth.
 Do you agree with him? Why or why not?
- What is the Professor trying to teach Peter and Susan? Is it merely logic, or is it something else as well? If so, what?
- Why does the Professor end by suggesting everyone mind their own business?
- Why do you think not talking about the wardrobe starts to help things get better for Lucy?
