

## **Book Discussion Group**

Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

## The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe Chapter 9:

- Why is it that the "good ordinary food" in front of Edmund isn't as desirable, as the "bad magic food" the White Witch gave him before?
- ❖ Now that we know when Edmund left, we know it did not take Lucy long to notice. Why did it not take her so long? Why was it that Lucy is the one to notice so quickly?
- Why is it, aside from the desire for more magical Turkish Delight, that Edmund is so quick to find excuses for the White Witch's evil deeds?
- ❖ Discuss the parts of Edmund's journey that are easy and the parts that are hard. How is this reflected in the path that leads towards evil?
- Why is it that when things go wrong Edmund focuses on his hatred of his brother Peter?
- ❖ Discuss Edmund's reaction to the lion turned to stone. Why does the lion's look of being "terrible, and sad, and noble" cause Edmund to realize that he wasn't getting "any fun our of jeering at it"?
- ❖ Compare the White Witch's reaction to Edmund to their encounter before. Does she seem as sweet and patient with him now as she was then?
