Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

The Magician's Nephew General Questions:

- In what ways does The Magician's Nephew recall the Creation Stories in the first three chapters of Genesis? In what ways does The Magician's Nephew differ from those stories?
- Why does it only take one small action by Digory to unleash a great evil? What does that say about the nature of sin?
- Discuss the help that Digory has on his path to redemption. Why does he need the help of others?
- How does the theme of redemption affect the various characters of The Magician's Nephew, including Digory?
- How does the theme of temptation affect the various characters of *The Magician's Nephew*, including Digory?
- Those around Aslan seem to notice that they, and others nearby, seem to possess more being when around the Lion. What does that say for God's affect on us?
- With all the power at Aslan's disposal, why does Aslan allow evil to continue to exist in Narnia?
- In what ways does C.S. Lewis use humour to teach us lessons about good and evil?
