Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

Prince Caspian Chapter 10:

- ❖ After the previous discussion on whether to follow Lucy's vision of Aslan or not, what do you make of the children already appearing to be lost by the end of the first paragraph in this chapter?
- ❖ Discuss Lewis' clarification that the children have been changed by Narnia to the extent that they are 1/3 the children they were before returning and 2/3 the kings and queens they were when they ruled Narnia.
- ❖ What do you think of Peter's remark, "I ought to have my head smacked for bringing us this way at all," after their encounter with the sentries?
- Why doesn't Lucy simply say "I told you so" after all they've been through?
- Discuss Lucy waking up "with the feeling that the voice she liked best in the world had been calling her name."
- ♦ How is Lucy's call from sleep similar to Samuel's call in 1 Samuel 3?
- ❖ In the last chapter, Lucy felt she had missed something in trying to talk with the trees. Do you think she is coming to understand what they were trying to say now? Why or why not?





- ❖ Compare the music Lucy hears to Aslan's singing at the start of creation in *The Magician's Nephew*.
- ❖ Compare Lucy's desire to dance with Caspian's dance with the Fauns in Chapter 6.
- ❖ What do you make of Aslan's stillness being such that except for the movement of Aslan's tail, the Lion could be compared with stone?
- ❖ Why do you think Aslan appears bigger to us the older we get?
- ❖ Do you think Lucy should have left the others to follow Aslan on her own? Why or why not?
- Why do you think no one is told what might have happened?
- What do you make of Aslan's remark that "It doesn't matter" if the others don't believe Lucy?
- ❖ Why do you think things never happen "the same way twice"?
- Why does Aslan say "us" in declaring "It has been hard for us all in Narnia before now"?
- ❖ How does Aslan's power make Lucy into "a lioness"?
- ❖ How is the trees' bowing in worship of Aslan still a dance?
- What do you think of Lucy's thought, on being asked to wake her siblings and Trumpkin, "I mustn't think about it, I must just do it"?
- What is it about Edmund that makes him the only one to believe Lucy?







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
