Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

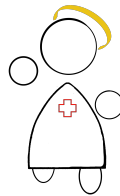
Prince Caspian Chapter 11:

- ❖ Why is Trumpkin so quick to dismiss all magic, especially given what he has witnessed with the former kings and queens of Narnia returning?
- ❖ Why is Aslan insistent that the group leaves now?
- ❖ Why is Peter's annoyance directed at Lucy as they get ready to leave and follow Aslan?
- ❖ Why does fixing her eyes on Aslan make Lucy forget all the things she wants to say to Susan?
- ❖ Why does Aslan remain invisible to the rest of the party?
- ❖ Does the amount of time it takes each of the party to see Aslan demonstrate their level of Faith?
- ❖ Discuss Susan's reactions throughout the chapter. Why has she been so quick to dismiss Aslan if deep down she truly believed?
- ❖ Why might not Susan need to say much to Aslan after her failure to act on her belief?
- ❖ Why does Aslan's image invoke both a sense of gladness and fear at the same time?
- ❖ Discuss Aslan's telling Susan she has been listening to her fears.
- ❖ Why, do you think, does Aslan like Trumpkin?

- ❖ Why would Bacchus be here with Aslan?
