

## **Book Discussion Group**

Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

## Prince Caspian Chapter 12:

- On seeing the old carvings on the walls in the Mound, carvings that would have been there after their reign over Narnia, Peter responds "That makes one think." Discuss his comment.
- Discuss Trufflehunter's comment that he stands by Aslan as well as his statement "Have patience".
- Do you agree with Trumpkin's thoughts that the rest of the troops shouldn't know what they were specifically hoping for when the trumpet was blown? Why or why not?
- Nikabrik's friends are the first to mention hatred and enemies.
  Discuss.
- Trufflehunter connects the calling of the ancient Kings and Queens with the calling of Aslan. Do you agree? Why or why not?
- What does it mean for Peter, Susan, Edmund, and Lucy to be Aslan's servants?
- Is it a coincidence that the creatures that do not speak fondly of Aslan were against Him in *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*?
- Why do you think there are so few stories of Aslan after his resurrection?
- What do you make of the plan to resurrect the White Witch?





- Discuss Peter's words to Caspian: "I haven't come to take your place, you know, but to put you into it."
- What do you make of Trufflehunter's comment that beasts don't change? Is this a good quality? Is it at least good here?
- Discuss Caspian's comment that Nikabrik "had gone sour from long suffering and hating."
- Do you think Nikabrik could have become good in days of peace?
  Why or why not?
- Why is it a good thing that they don't know who killed Nikabrik?
- Why does Peter suggest giving Nikabrik's body back to his people?
- Should the hag and the werewolf also be returned to their people like Nikabrik? Why or why not?
