Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

Prince Caspian Chapter 15:

- ❖ Why are the talking beasts the ones that don't fear Aslan, but see the Lion as a friend?
- Why is it important that Caspian not feel sufficient to be King of Narnia?
- Why is Caspian placed under Aslan and then the High King Peter as King of Narnia?
- Why does Aslan have Lucy perform the healing of Reepicheep?
- Why does Aslan talk as one who already knows Reepicheep, even through they have only just met?
- Discuss Aslan's giving in to Reepicheep's request for the return his tail not due to his dignity, but for the love of his people.
- Should having a tail matter so much to Reepicheep? Why or why not?
- ❖ Discuss the mice who chewed away the cords surrounding Aslan on the Stone Table in *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* becoming talking mice as a result.
- Why do you think that Aslan chooses to stay and feast with the Narnians after their ordeal?





- ❖ What do you think of Aslan providing another home for those

 Telmarines unwilling to live in a Narnia that belongs equally to men,

 talking beasts, and other creatures?
- ❖ Why do you think the older men, especially those who had important positions under Miraz, are unwilling to live in Narnia they are not able to rule?
- ❖ Compare the whining of the Telmarines to the whining of the Ancient Israelites in Torah.
- ❖ Discuss Aslan's statement about the lineage of Adam and Eve: "It is both honor enough to erect the head of the poorest beggar, and shame enough to bow the shoulders of the greatest emperor on earth."
- Why does Aslan bestow great fortune on the first Telmarine to enter the door?
- Discuss Peter, Susan, Edmund, and Lucy going in the doorway to prove to the Telmarines that Aslan means them no harm.
