Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

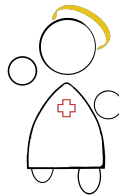
Prince Caspian Chapter 5:

- ❖ Why do you think Miraz disapproves of Caspian learning about the sea?
- ❖ Caspian starts to learn “a great deal by using his own eyes and ears.”
What is the role of experience in uncovering the Truth?
- ❖ Discuss the revelation of Miraz as an usurper to the throne. Feel free to include your feelings in the discussion.
- ❖ Compare Miraz to Oliver Cromwell. Examine their respective titles as well.
- ❖ What do you make of Caspian’s question of “What harm have I done” to uncle Miraz? Does that make any difference in Miraz’s approach to him? Why or why not?
- ❖ What does it say about Miraz that he was willing to kill his own brother for power?
- ❖ What does it mean that a true king, like Caspian, can glory in going off to adventure one moment and feel “frightened and small” the next?
- ❖ In Caspian’s journey, it becomes clear there is a great divide between Narnia and the Telmarines. Has Miraz’s plan succeeded?





- ❖ What do you make of Nikabrik, who as a dwarf is “as forgetful and changeable as the Humans themselves”, being the one who advocates for killing Caspian?
- ❖ What do you make of the fact that even Narnians doubt in Aslan now?
