

## **Book Discussion Group**

Here are some questions to help get you started with your discussion.

## Prince Caspian Chapter 8:

- What do you make of the time the trumpet was blown in Narnia being the same time the children were swept away from their own world?
- What do you make of the children still being "on call" for Narnia, even after their reign over the land is long over?
- Discuss how Peter, Susan, Edmund, and Lucy appear in a form
  Caspian and the others did not at all expect.
- Do you agree with Trumpkin that Peter, Susan, Edmund, and Lucy are less helpful because they are children? Why or why not?
- Edmund is quick to take Lucy's advice. Compare that to how they interacted in *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*.
- What do you make of Edmund's fencing bout to prove themselves to Trumpkin?
- What does it say about Trumpkin that in being proven wrong he is able to admit "talking like a fool"?
- Even though they are children, Peter, Susan, Edmund, and Lucy possess knowledge that has long been lost to Narnia. Discuss this juxtaposition.
